

CITY OF PROVIDENCE SPECIAL EVENT PERMITTING GUIDE FOR SEPTEMBER 8-10, 2023

FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2023

- Block parties and expansions into parking lots will be considered
- Expansion into parking spaces and sidewalks will be considered
- Outdoor music must end by 1AM
- Outdoor closing time for all applications will be 2AM
- Security required

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 9, 2023

- Expansion into parking spaces and sidewalks will be considered.
- Block parties and expansions into parking lots will not be considered.
- Outdoor music must end by 12AM
- Outdoor closing time for all applications will be 1AM

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 10, 2023

- Expansion into parking spaces and sidewalks will be considered
- Block parties and Expansions into parking lots will not be considered
- Outdoor music must end by 11PM
- Outdoor closing time for all applications will be 12AM

GUIDELINES

- All drinks must stay contained within the footprint designated by the Special Event Permit.
- Plastic cups only while serving outdoors.
- ADA Accessibility on all sidewalks within special event footprint (4ft clearance).
- Incident Action Plan may be requested by the Providence Emergency Management Agency for Friday night activations.
- Special Event Permit holders are not permitted to use the PVDFest logo on any promotional materials.

APPLICATION TIMELINE

- All Special Event Applications are due by August 7. We are unable to offer any extensions, this is a hard deadline. Thank you for your understanding.
- The City Service Meeting for all Special Event Applicants will be held August 9, 2023.

KEEP IN MIND

- Applying to host a Special Event the weekend September 8-10 does not guarantee permit approval.
- Applications not received by August 7, 20203 will not be considered for a Special Event Permit for the weekend of September 8-10, 2023.
